

Glenn Giles is Music Department Chair at Castleton State College. He previously served as Fine Arts Supervisor for the Rutland City Schools, his teaching assignments there included: Middle School Concert Band Director, High School Jazz Ensemble Director and brass instructor. He has taught in the Rutland area for 41 years, and has directed the Rutland City Band; Proctor Community Chorus; and the Lakes Region Youth Orchestra Junior Winds.

He currently conducts the Lakes Region Youth Orchestra Wind Ensemble. He is also Bass Trombonist in the EnerJazz Big Band. Mr. Giles attended Lowell State College and Eastern Nazarene College in Massachusetts, and received a Bachelor of Science in Music Education degree from Castleton State College in Vermont. He received his Master of Music Degree in instrumental conducting at the University of Maine where he studied conducting with Dennis Cox, Curvin Farnham, Arnald Gabriel, Anthony Maiello, and John Williamson.

Glenn has been a guest conductor/clinician in the three Northern New England States. As an active member of the Vermont Music Educators Association, he has adjudicated for the Vermont All-State Music Festival and Green Mountain District Festival and is a past president of the association. Mr. Giles' other professional organizations and honors fraternities include the Music Educators National Conference, National Federation Interscholastic Music Association and Pi Kappa Lambda National Music Honor Society.
